ALABAMA BRIDES: A SHORT ENGAGEMENT AT THE MUSEUM OF ALABAMA

Montgomery, AL (6/4/15) – The Museum of Alabama will debut a special, temporary exhibit called *Alabama Brides: A Short Engagement* on June 4, 2015. It will be on display in the second floor lobby of the Alabama Department of Archives and History (ADAH) through October 2, 2015. The exhibit will feature wedding dresses dating from circa 1910 to 2013, highlighting the evolution of wedding fashions and traditions through the decades. Also on display will be memorabilia from Alabama weddings of the past including wedding china, invitations, gift registries, and more. The exhibit is located in the second floor lobby.

The Museum of Alabama is located at the Alabama Department of Archives and History in downtown Montgomery across the street from the State Capitol. Regular hours of operation are Monday through Saturday, 8:30 to 4:30 and admission is always free. Parking is available in a free lot directly behind the Archives' building on Adams Avenue.
